HOW WE GOT INTO THE BREED

- Colanta starts paying for protein. (Cheese propaganda)
- My dad is a visionary: suggests the breed, but I refused.
- Start crossbreeding: the best with the best.
- University: Professor Ruben Galvis (former JETA winner) asks to collaborate on an investigation: IN A JERSEY HERD!

- Bought first group of 5 Jerseys to the herd! Color is ON!!!
- First program of milk samples for % of solids starts in Colombia.
- Start working with the National Association as classifier.

THE FIRST DAYS WITH JERSEYS IN THE FARM

- Goal: 30% inclusion of the breed (Suggested by Coop)
- Neighbors: "you will broke"
- Started pricing milk from each cow: "The goal went to 100% JE
- Jerseys grazing with Holsteins.
- Learn the breed: first heifers were hard to breed (waited too long).
